The youngest Sahibzade were at a tender age when they spent the last few nights of their life, imprisoned with their grandmother Mata Gujri Ji, in freezing conditions before being bricked alive, for refusing to bow down to tyranny by renouncing their faith and beliefs. They remained righteous and defiant until their last breath. To commemorate the supreme sacrifice of Sahibzade, Mata Gujri Ji and all the Singhs and Singhniya, this month we will reflect upon the history and pay tribute to these great martyrs.
