Genius Day Celebration!

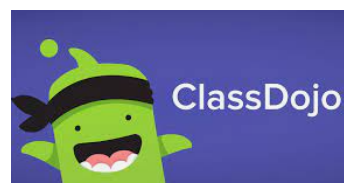


